
Regulations of making payments to Campus Bemke Foundation via campusbemke.pl

(hereinafter referred to as „Regulations“)

1. General Provisions

- 1.1. The Regulations define the rules and conditions for making donations to the Campus Bemke Foundation (hereinafter referred to as the “Foundation”) via the website campusbemke.pl.
- 1.2. Payments made via campusbemke.pl will be allocated to the statutory purposes of the Foundation.

2. Donations via the Website campusbemke.pl

- 2.1. Payments made via campusbemke.pl are secure, as they are transferred to the Foundation through trusted online payment operators.
- 2.2. Donations can be one-time or recurring.
- 2.3. Users can donate any amount at their discretion.
- 2.4. Payments can be made via AutoPay – the transaction is free of charge.
- 2.5. To use campusbemke.pl, users need a device with internet access.

3. Donation Confirmation

- 3.1. To obtain a donation confirmation, users must send a request to kontakt@campusbemke.pl along with a bank transfer confirmation. These details are necessary to locate and verify the payment in our payment system. If the provided information is insufficient, we may ask for additional details.
- 3.2. The confirmation will be sent within a month from the request date (provided all necessary details are included).
- 3.3. Confirmations will not be issued after one year from the donation date.



4. Personal Data

- 4.1. The administrator of personal data is Campus Bemke Foundation, headquartered in Klecza Dolna, at Krakowska 4, 34-124 Klecza Górna, registered in the National Court Register under KRS number 0000960145, NIP 5512653624, REGON 521472833.

- 4.3. Personal data will be processed to accept monetary donations made via the Foundation's website in accordance with these Regulations (Article 6(1)(b) of the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679).
- 4.4. Personal data will not be processed automatically, including profiling.
- 4.5. Data will be stored for the period required by law and the time necessary to establish, pursue, or defend claims.
- 4.6. Data recipients include online payment operators, IT service providers, and other entities authorized under separate legal provisions.
- 4.7. You have the right to request access to personal data, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, objection to processing, and data portability.
- 4.8. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary to process donations within the program.
- 4.9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office



5. Final Provisions

- 5.1. The Foundation reserves the right to amend the Regulations at any time.
- 5.2. By making a donation via campusbemke.pl, users accept the terms of the Regulations.
